By July, almost every part of the country had been attacked by ASF. In only two months, the number of dead pigs has risen to 50,000. Though ASF started in the south, the east of the country is the worst hit area. By this week, 80% of the farms in Ox State have reported cases of ASF.

The sale of pork in Ox State has declined because of ASF. Before ASF, the sale of pork in Ox State was \$2.5 million each week; now it is less than \$500,000.

Rooster State is the only area in the north without cases of ASF. Before we know how to deal with ASF, we can only hope Rooster State will be lucky enough not to experience the 42 of this killer disease.





Stressed Out? Doctor's Advice: Smile

Many studies have 43 that exercise and diet are an important part of a healthy lifestyle, but one doctor recommends something more: smiling.

Dr. Smith is a heart doctor and he tells his patients to smile because he believes it's the first step in 44 stress.

"Once people smile, they are relaxing," Dr. Smith said. "Relaxation lowers blood pressure and improves sugar levels in the blood." His 45 is supported by a number of studies.

When you 46, your body releases a lot of 47. If you are truly in danger, these 47 are helpful, but having too many of them in the blood can lead to heart disease and stroke.


That is why Dr. Smith tells his patients to smile 20 times an hour. It might seem like a lot, 48 he says it works.
