B. Louis Braille was born in France in 1809. His father had a small business making leather goods. One day , Louis Braille went into this father's workshop to cut some leather. Suddenly the knife slipped and hit him in the eye. An infection soon spread to his other eye , and Louis went completely blind.

At ten , Louis entered a school for the blind. One day his class went to visit a special exhibit. Here Louis learned about a special military code , which was made up of raised letters written on very thick paper.

Louis decided to write in the same way so blind people could "read " with their fingers. However , it was very difficult to feel the differences between letters. Instead , Braille developed his own system using a series of six dots. Today , Louis Braille's system is used around the world.
